POLICY & PROCEDURES – 2022-001

PLAYER REGISTRATION AND PATHWAY

Policy

SCYCA training program consists of three levels based on a player's skill level. Refer to the SCYCA website www.scycricketacademy.com for the fee structure and schedule for corresponding levels of training.

Program

Level - 1 Basic Training

Entry level for all new players.

Exception: New player with higher skill level will be evaluated by the Head Coach before placing them at the appropriate Level.

Program is offered 2 days a week.

Level - 2 Intermediate Training

Players with an intermediate level of skill.

Players who have gone through basic training and have demonstrated adequate skill get promoted to this level with the approval of the Head Coach.

Program is offered 3 days a week.

Level - 3 Advanced Training

Players with an advanced level of skill.

Players are promoted to this group with the approval of the Head Coach.

Program is offered 5 days a week.

Payments

1. Coaching fee is based on a quarterly structure (3 months). Quarterly fees are nonrefundable. Fees paid for future quarters will be refunded only a valid reason provided via on a written request to the Secretary of SCYCA. The SCYCA Board must then approve the request for a refund.
2. The coaching fee is only affordable because of the volunteer coaching staff. All players are expected to consider SCYCA as the primary club if a player belongs to multiple clubs.
3. All players must order their uniform through SCYCA. Additional fees are applicable to cover the cost. Refer to the SCYCA website for uniform cost.

** Training dates can be changed by the SCYCA administration at its discretion based on the availability of practice fields, facilities, and coaches.

Procedure

The head coach will obtain a list of players recommended for the next level from their respective coaches Towards the end of each quarter. The head coach will then promote qualified players to the appropriate Level based on the skill level of the players and on the availability and on the availability of openings in the respective levels.

** The SCYCA board may change the coaching structure at its own discretion to suit the needs and requirement of the Academy in its present Circumstance.
